

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

"This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." The true test/sign of being in the company of Jesus, for the first disciples and for us in 2013, is thus inter-personal *agape* (self-giving love), modeled after Christ. A solitary or self-absorbed Christian is a contradiction in terms. Thanks to Christ's gifts of the Eucharist, our lives and destiny are interconnected by an unbreakable bond, called the **ONE TRUE LIVING BODY of CHRIST**.

Living Christ's commandment of love is our reason to participate in the Archdiocese's Annual Catholic Appeal. This year Sacred Heart is assessed to contribute \$40,157 to support over 60 ministries and services throughout the Western Washington. Thanks to your generosity, we exceeded our goal by 11% last year, from 65% of parishioners participated. With your continuing kindness, we can improve to 75% or even 80% participation this year.

Note that every dollar donated over the assessment goes back to Sacred Heart. This year our parish's actual goal is \$87,157 which includes \$47,000 to replace our 80 year old heating system in the Mother of Perpetual Hall and school building. In recent years we have pumped a chunk of money into maintaining this system. Why this building? It has been actively utilized as rental space to Waldorf High School and to the Downtown Emergency Service Center for men's overnight shelter. Our rental income provides over 30% of parish needed revenue to sustain our everyday ministries.

Another note: Your gift could go further, in fact be doubled. How? "Request a Matching Gift form from your employer or go online to your company giving station. Together, you and your employer can send a message of hope to people in our community. Thank you for making the extra effort."

Our parish celebrates "<u>May Crowning</u>," a beautiful tradition of honoring our Blessed Mary, on Mother's Day weekend (May 11-12). Also on this occasion, we will also honor our mothers, both living and deceased, at all our Masses. We suggest a way to honor her – "<u>Spiritual Bouquet for Mom</u>." Envelopes are available in the front vestibule for Mass Intentions. They can also be used for financial donation to give flowers to all mothers at weekend Masses.

May the Risen Christ continue to fill you and your extended family with his divine love!


