Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

This Sunday the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Baptism of Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Jordan. This brings to an end the season of Christmas, and begins the season of the Ordinary Time.

The Church uses this Sunday, the First Sunday in Ordinary Time, to celebrate the feast of the Baptism of the Lord and to invite us to reflect on our own baptism. When we receive the Sacrament of the Baptism, we are the people of God, the Body of Christ, and the community of the Holy Spirit in which each member has her or his ministry; and through the Baptism, God calls each one of us to receive a new life—life of sanctifying grace. Sister Dianne Bergant, C.S.A, the Professor of Biblical Studies at the Catholic Theological Union in

Chicago describes: “Through baptism, Christians move from sleep to wakefulness, from death to new life, from darkness to illumination. It is clear from these metaphors that, through baptism, Christians have entered into a new state of being that will require of them a new way of living.” And yet, I believe that our new way of living in Baptism is always about the conversion:...”renewal in mind and heart, tasting more deeply the sweetness of God’s word, receiving the fellowship of the Holy Spirit, and growing in the knowledge of the goodness of the Lord (RCIA, 245)” (*Saying Amen—A Mystagogy of Sacrament, Kathleen Hughes, 14*). When we have a heart of conversion in our Christian lives, we are opened to let Jesus’ Word and example reshape our thoughts, our behaviors, and our conduct in order to love and serve the Lord through loving and serving our brothers and sisters in all we say and in all we do.

Today and every day, we pray: “Almighty, eternal God, when the Spirit descended upon Jesus at his baptism in the Jordan, you revealed him as your own beloved Son. Keep us, your children born of water and the Spirit, faithful to our calling. We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy, one God, for ever and ever. Amen” (The Opening Prayer for the Baptism of the Lord)

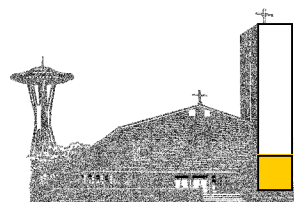
