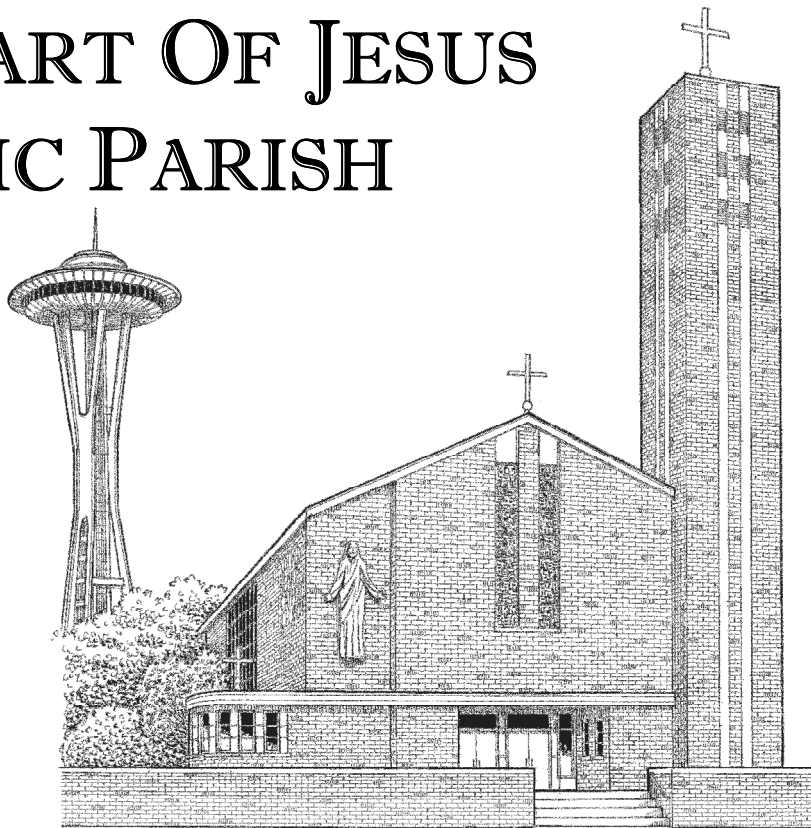

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

We are at the halfway point of Lent. There are only two more Sundays in the Lenten season before entering into the Easter season. The Fourth Sunday of Lent is known as *Laetare* Sunday (or "Rose Sunday"). The vestments of the celebrant for this Sunday may be colored rose in place of the penitential violet. The rose vestments are a symbol of joy and hope. It is fitted to the Entrance Antiphon for today: "Rejoice, Jerusalem! Be glad for her, you who love her; rejoice with her, you who mourned for her, and you will find contentment at her consoling breasts" (Isaiah 66:10-11). The Scripture readings for this Sunday also urge us to be joyful and hopeful in Christ, our healer and Savior. The blind man was healed by Jesus, not only physically but also in spiritual sight, as he believed in Jesus as Savior and Messiah. May we come to Jesus asking Him to open our eyes (physically and spiritually) to see the wondrous things that Christ has done for us.

Today we have the annual second collection for Catholic Relief Services right after the Holy Communion. Thirty percent of this collection will be designated for the Japanese disaster relief. The rest will provide for catastrophic events, fight disease and poverty, and nurture peaceful and just societies around the world. You can donate at the second collection or online at [www.crs.org](http://www.crs.org) or send a check to the Missions Office, payable to Catholic Relief Services noting "Japan Relief" in the memo section. I would like to encourage you to support this effort.

April 2011 is the month of the Holy Eucharist. One thing that sets Catholics apart from other Christians is that we believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the form of bread and wine. Every time we receive Holy Communion, we receive the whole person of Christ, as He is at the present moment with His glorified body and soul and His full divinity. The month of April reminds us of God's loving presence with us in the Eucharist as He said: "This is my body ... This is my blood, do this in memory of me."

Since Lent began, every Thursday from 1:00 to 6:30 pm, we have a fair number of parishioners coming to the Chapel for the Blessed Sacrament adoration. As we know, frequent prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, reserved in the tabernacle or Eucharistic adoration is a path to spiritual growth. I hope to see more of you on this path.
