

Today Jesus tells his disciples that "he was destined to go to Jerusalem and suffer grievously at the hands of the elders and chief priests and scribes, to be put to death and to be raised up on the third day." What a heart-wrenching shock for the disciples, that their Messiah be humiliated with a shameful death, in the holy city of Jerusalem, by their own religious leaders. No wonder Peter tried to change his teacher's mind. Jesus, in return, harshly reminded Peter that his intervention was the devil's work, thinking in purely human terms rather than with "the mind of God."

St. Paul also urges Christians not to model themselves on "selfish behavior of the culture of death," but to take on a new mind of Christ through loving service. Christ-like service is "truly pleasing to God" and will eventually bring lasting joy, freedom, and peace.

This week we welcome Fr. Scott Harris to our community. At all weekend Masses he will help us grow in "the mind of Christ," giving us an opportunity to support Maryknoll missionary works throughout the world. Please be generous to his appeal.

Please check out the bulletin insert for two exciting news: First, starting this September, there will be a "Healing Mass" at 5:30 p.m. every second Saturday of the month. Essentially this Mass still takes place at our regularly scheduled Saturday Vigil. Immediately after Mass, everyone is invited to participate in the "Anointing of the Sick." This anointing is a sacred ritual to invoke God's gift of healing on people who are stressed with life's conditions (i.e., physical, mental, emotional, spiritual).

Secondly, as we have heard for months, the entire Catholic Church in the U.S. will put into practice a new Roman Missal (i.e., way of celebrating the Eucharist), starting the First Sunday of Advent (November 27). Every other weekend from now until November 27th, a bulletin insert will feature various topics of the new Roman Missal to help prepare ourselves effectively. Please take the necessary time to familiarize yourself with the new changes.
