

Dear Parishioners,



Fr. Joe asked me to write something this week for the bulletin – like telling the folks who I am and where I have been. I'll give it a try.

I was born in Portland, Oregon and raised in the Redemptorist parish of Holy Redeemer. My education from high school on to ordination was with the Redemptorists. I professed my vows in 1957 and was ordained in 1962. I served in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho for three years and then six years in Alaska. I was very happy working on the Kenai peninsula, Kodiak, and in Anchorage, but then the superiors decided I should be pastor and superior in Great Falls, Montana. Four years later, I was made pastor/superior of my home parish in Portland. After six years at Holy Redeemer I put in three years as the Provincial Consultor in San Francisco, California.

In 1987, I was asked to be the superior of the founding community in Nigeria. We opened a new parish in Lagos and three years later we accepted our first candidates for the Redemptorists. Twenty one years later I turned the new Vice Province of Nigeria over to the local men and returned to the States. My time in Nigeria was the most challenging, yet rewarding time of my Redemptorist life. I thank God each day for the success of our mission there. I left over 50 Nigerian priests and 65 major seminarians. God certainly blessed our labors. The new Vice Province is now sharing their wealth of vocations with about a dozen men working overseas in priest-poor areas.

When I returned to the States, I was asked where I would like to be stationed. I chose Sacred Heart Seattle....being from the Northwest and never having been stationed here. I can say that it has been a very happy experience for me to be with all of you and working in the Archdiocese of Seattle. It really is like coming home for me.

I was honored when Fr. Grile asked me to be the associate parish priest with Fr. Joe Thong Ngo. Together we will work to keep up the good traditions of Redemptorist service to the people of Seattle. Sacred Heart parish has a long tradition of service to the poor, to the ministry of confessions and Masses and for the devotions to our Mother of Perpetual Help. As the oldest parish in the Seattle area, we have high standards to uphold. We will do our best, and pray that we can measure up to the caliber of the many famous Redemptorists that have gone before us.

My motto has always been "to serve, not be served". I am here to offer you whatever services I am capable of – and to get to know you as family. Thank you for your acceptance – all of you are in my daily prayers and Masses.
