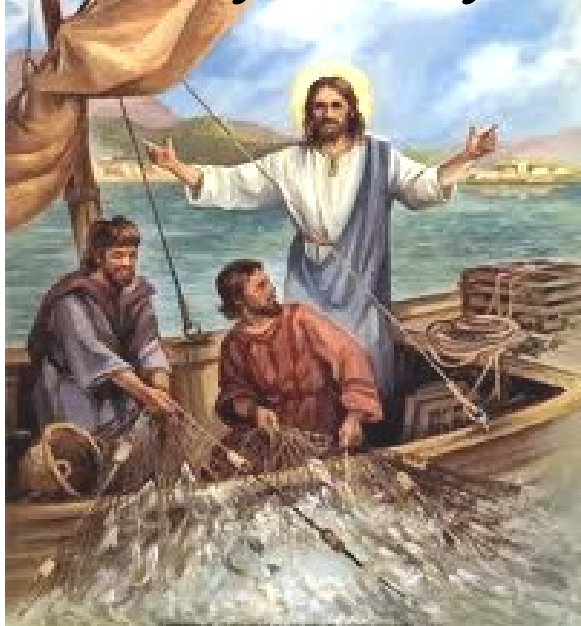

Dear Parishioners,

Let me begin with a story: "Service for One"

On Sunday, the new young pastor arrived at church and found only an old farmer had shown up. After waiting a while, the disappointed pastor remarked to the old farmer, "Well, it appears no one else is coming, so we should probably cancel service today."

The farmer, dressed in his Sunday best, looked at the young preacher and said, "Well pastor, I don't know much 'bout preachin', but I do know something 'bout farmin' and if I went out in the field and found only one cow, I'd still feed 'em"

This excited the young preacher who preached for the next 45 minutes a fierce fire and brimstone sermon. Afterwards the pastor asked the old farmer what he thought.

The old farmer remarked, "Well pastor, I don't know much 'bout preachin', but I do know some thin' 'bout farmin' and if I went out in the field and found only one cow, I wouldn't give 'em the whole bale." (Source: Unknown)

I think the new young pastor learned a good lesson from the farmer. I hope I also learn good lessons from you.

This is my fourth week as a pastor of Sacred Heart. Some people asked me: "How do I feel? Am I excited? Am I worried? Am I afraid? Am I responsible for more things? Am I having more authority over the parish? ... etc." I thought I said "Yes" to some questions, and "No" to the others. However, I was sleepless in Seattle last two weeks. I probably worried too much on how to fulfill my role as the pastor here.

Let me share with you the pastor's role according to the book "*Many gifts, One Spirit: Church Governance through Consultative Leadership*" from the Archdiocese of Seattle. It describes: "The pastor's role, expressed in its threefold mission of teaching, governing and sanctifying (CIC, c. 519), empowers the laity for their mission as light and leaven in the world." Teaching, governing, and sanctifying ministries are challenging for me. I know, I am not worthy to teach, govern, and sanctify you. I am honest with you that I have learned from you and have been sanctified by many of you since I came here. Your Christian life is a mirror helping me to reflect and live up to my own Christian life. However, I am appointed to carry on these roles in the Parish. And yet I know you will pray, support, and help me to do my best. I'm grateful for your accepting me in your midst.

Now, thank God. I sleep well every night. I do not worry too much. I'm trying to do my best, and let God does the rest. I wish you do the same.
