



Dear Parishioners,

Last Sunday we reflected on the surprise calling of Jesus' disciples. They were fishermen and *Father* ordinary people. However, they were chosen by Jesus to do God's mission. This Sunday, Jesus taught His disciples who God loves and who they would become: the poor in spirit, the mourners, the meek, the hungry and thirsty for righteousness, the merciful, the clean of heart, and the peace

makers. The disciples of Jesus are not merely His followers; they are supposed to live up and work for these Beatitudes. By our baptism, we are called to do the same.

Also last Sunday, I shared with you the pastor's role, which is to teach, govern, sanctify, and empower the laity for their mission as light and leaven in the world. This Sunday, I would like to share with you what the Catholic parish is about. According to the book "Many gifts, One Spirit: Church Governance through Consultative Leadership" from the Archdiocese of Seattle, "The parish is a community of believers sharing in the mission of the Church...Because it is a community of Christian faithful; it is essential that the parish structures serve the community in carrying out the mission of the church: sanctification of the world through proclamation of the Gospel, celebration of the sacraments and service to those in need." (p. 19).

This description of the parish helps us live our Christian faith fully and meaningfully in the community of believers. The Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish has 441 parishioners and around 700 people attending the Sunday Masses. Why does the Parish ask you to become a member or parishioner? Because the Parish would like you to be a part of the mission of the Church: to sanctify the world through proclamation of the Gospel, to celebrate the sacraments, and to serve to those in need.

I pray and hope that you have the strength and courage to be a part of the Parish in order to do the mission of the Church. I would like to conclude with a poem written by a homeless woman after she asked for help from her church but received nothing in return. In desperation, she wrote:

I was hungry and you formed a group to discuss my hunger. I was imprisoned and you quietly crept off to your chapel to pray for my release. I was naked and in your mind you debated the morality of my appearance. I was sick and you knelt and thanked God for His help. I was homeless and you preached to me about the spiritual shelter of God's love. I was lonely and you left me alone to pray for me. You seem so holy, so close to God, but I am still very hungry, lonely, and cold.

May this poem help us reflect upon our Christian calling. Fr. Joe Thong Ngo, C.Ss.R.
