

Father Mark Scheffler comes to us also with good credentials for working in our parish. He was a vocation director in the New Orleans Vice Province for some years, and recently he has been involved in ministering to our older and sick men at St. Clement's Health Care Center in Ligouri, Missouri. Thru the years, he has been involved in youth ministry. I think you will find that we are very blest to have him as our parochial vicar.

Here at Sacred Heart Parish, we are blest to have the assistance of four older men to help out in the parish when needed. Our main ministry here consists of Confessions, Masses, preaching - and some Baptisms, Weddings, and funerals. 
