Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish,

AS I SEE IT...now that I have completed my assignment as parochial vicar for the past six months:

It has been a good experience. It has brought back many memories of the years I spent in the same position in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho; Fresno, California; parishes in Anchorage, Kodiak, and Soldotna, Alaska - and lastly, in Satellite Town, Nigeria. It is a good position to be in. You are involved in ministry in every way, but do not have the responsibility of "running" the parish. Once you are made the pastor, then you take on all the duties of ministry, plus the administration of the parish...and many times as the superior of the Redemptorist community also. Our new pastor/superior - Father Binh Ta has a good number of years of experience as both parochial vicar and also as pastor. He was also in the Vice Provincial government of the Redemptorists in New Orleans. So he comes with good credentials. I think we are blest to have him appointed here at Sacred Heart.

Father Mark Scheffler comes to us also with good credentials for working in our parish. He was a vocation director in the New Orleans Vice Province for some years, and recently he has been involved in ministering to our older and sick men at St. Clement's Health Care Center in Ligouri, Missouri. Thru the years, he has been involved in youth ministry. I think you will find that we are very blest to have him as our parochial vicar.

Here at Sacred Heart Parish, we are blest to have the assistance of four older men to help out in the parish when needed. Our main ministry here consists of Confessions, Masses, preaching - and some Baptisms, Weddings, and funerals. Our help will lighten the load of the two priests - and be of assistance to neighboring parishes.

I want to thank all of you for your support, encouragement, and camaraderie these past six months. I will still be here at Sacred Heart - in residence. I will be available to help out in the parish here and in the other parishes of the Archdiocese as needed. We older priests are very much in demand. As you know, most parishes only have one priest. If he wants to have any time away - he has to find a replacement. We are available to help all priests and parishes upon request for this ministry.

The Redemptorists have a long tradition in the Archdiocese of Seattle for helping our fellow priests and neighboring parishes. It is our intention to continue this important ministry - and we thank God that we have pretty good health for such ministry.

I look forward to our new parish team of Redemptorists and to the new additions to our community here at Sacred Heart. Thank you for the past six months. It has been fun and very rewarding for me to work with Father Joe Thong Ngo. I wish him God speed and a rewarding experience as he moves on to his new appointment as parochial vicar in Biloxi, Mississippi.

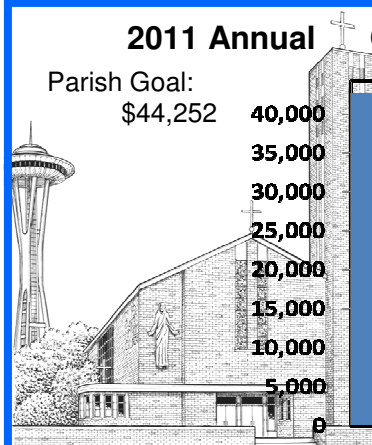

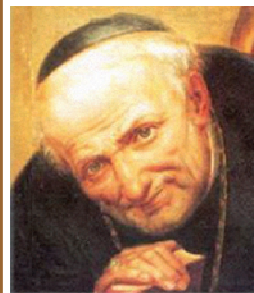
