During that time I started a Marriage Encounter Weekend and eventually began helping and supporting married couples and their vocation in any way I could.

Twice I was appointed Vocation Director for the Redemptorist Fathers and during some fifteen years I had the wonderful opportunity of visiting all of our communities and encouraging young people to share their gifts and lives however God may be calling them to do. And in between these two appointments I had the privilege of serving as a hospital and hospice chaplain. The wisdom moments and life learnings of the fragile and dying influenced me significantly.

Several years of coordinating and encouraging young adult ministry in our parishes and across our Denver Province led up to my being appointed as assistant director and chaplain at St. Clement Health Care Center. There, for the past two and a half years, I have had the privilege of caring for Redemptorist priests and brothers in their senior years.

And now, I will be with you again! I look forward to it and to eventually meeting all of you! That's when you will learn my favorite color and food; my favorite music and movies; and...but know that I will ask the same of you. Thank you for yesterday and may God wonderfully bless us into all of our tomorrows together!

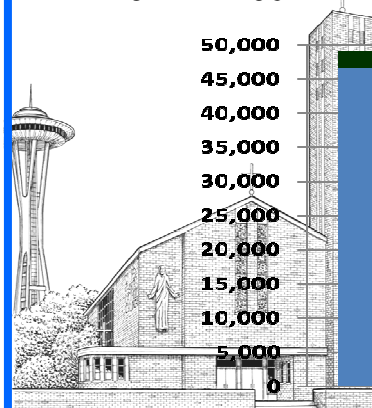
