

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish,

AS I SEE IT... Sacred Heart Parish here in Seattle is unique. We are the oldest existing parish in the city of Seattle. The Redemptorists came to Sacred Heart in 1890 and began their missionary work in the north end of the city of Seattle and beyond. Our Mother of Perpetual Help parish in Everett was begun by the Redemptorists along with St. Alphonsus parish in Ballard, Immaculate Conception parish in Mt. Vernon, and St. Anne's parish on Queen Anne Hill. But there was one thing that made Sacred Heart Parish unique. And that is the picture of OUR MOTHER OF PERPETUAL HELP.

The Redemptorists were given this picture - in- Rome - by Pope Pius IX in 1866. At that time, the Holy Father told the Redemptorists to "make Our Mother of Perpetual Help known throughout the world." Shortly after that time, the first reproductions of the Mother of Perpetual Help pictures arrived in America. When the Redemptorists came to Sacred Heart, they brought the picture with them and started the novena devotions. Today, you will find that particular picture in many churches throughout the whole Northwest - and in just about every country of the world.

This particular devotion is very important today because the picture comes to us from the Eastern Catholic Church of Greece. I think it is possible that this will be the link we need to bring about the reconciliation between the Eastern and the Western Catholic Churches. Pope Benedict XVI has made this a top priority during his pontificate. Progress is being made, and if we continue to pray and work at trying to understand each other better, possibly we will see a unity of the two churches.

Devotion to Mary has been strong in both the Eastern and Western Churches down through the years, and I think Mary will bring us together - because it is the wish of her Son. Novena devotions are still being held each Tuesday here at Sacred Heart - morning, noon, and evening. Along with the devotions, we offer the sacrament of Reconciliation before all our daily Masses.

The Redemptorists are proud to be part of the plan of the Redeemer to bring unity to the Christian churches. We are proud that we can serve the needs of the Seattle Archdiocese and provide an opportunity for people to come out to the Mother of God with their prayers and petitions. She is the greatest intercessor we have before the throne of her Son.

May Our Mother of Perpetual Help continue to intercede for all of us and bring about that long sought unity of the whole Catholic Church.


