Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart:

This past Wednesday we celebrated the feast of All Souls. Praying for the faithful departed is an ancient, noble Christian tradition. Besides human desire to remain connected with our deceased loved ones, this tradition is rooted in our abiding trust that God's mercy always has room for those who actively seek to be reconciled with and to grow toward God. During November we, with love and in solidarity, continue to support our departed family, friends, parishioners, neighbors, etc., in their mending process by offering Masses, praying rosaries, participating in Eucharistic adoration, visiting cemeteries, and being charitable. As we support our dearly departed, they in turn intercede for us, as we earthly pilgrims trek on to God.

Starting this week we begin our annual stewardship consideration. Stewardship, what is it really? At its core, stewardship starts with God and his abundance. Our generous God is the source of infinite abundance. All that we are and all that we have is a gift from this generous God. In gratitude we dedicate a portion of our entrusted gifts – time, talent, and money – to furthering God's work here on earth. There are five basic convictions to Stewardship sharing:

- 1) It is a **gift**, sharing with free will;
- 2) it is **planned**, with thought and resolve;
- 3) it is **proportionate** to the gift we have received;
- 4) it is **sacrificial** in that we give from our substance, not just what is left over; and
- 5) it is given in **gratitude** for the immense love God has shown us.

Next weekend, your fellow parishioners will share with you on a practical way to live out these faith-filled convictions. Please pray for God's guidance on our discernment!

On the note of gratitude, I would like to thank all of you who recently registered to be members of Sacred Heart's community of faith. What an inspiring testimony of your desire to grow in knowing and loving God. Thank you! This coming week I PROMISE to personally contact you to learn how your faith community can support you towards God.
