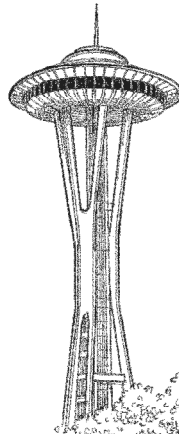

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart:

In telling the parable of the talents, Jesus aims to convey a simple yet direct message: Wisely use God-given gift, or tragically lose it! Like the servants in today's gospel, each one of us has been entrusted with varying amounts of "talents" (i.e., gifts of life, faith, time, skill, and money). The key issue is not how much we have been given, but what have we been doing with God's unique gifts to you and me.

This weekend we welcome members of the Stewardship Commission as witness speakers to Christian way of Living Stewardship. Being a good steward practically implies sharing a portion of God's entrusted gifts with others, including Sacred Heart parish. Our sharing (i.e., giving back to God) is a faithful response to God's deep and generous love for us, which you and I know can never be outdone.
