Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart:

On this World Mission Sunday (WMS), my heart swells with gratitude, for this day marks the anniversary of my (and your) baptism. When we were baptized, each of us became a missionary. Regarding our vocation as missionaries, Pope Benedict XVI prays, "May the [WMS] reawaken in each person the joy and desire to 'go' out to meet humanity, taking Christ to all."

Most of us perhaps are unable to travel to distant lands as St. Francis Xavier did. However we can – through daily prayer and sacrifice – support those who have left their comfortable home to bring Christ to others. This WMS reminds me of two dear friends, Liz and Michael Nguyen, who left Houston (Texas) to work with street children and prostitutes in Thailand to rebuild lives. I also recall Fr. J.B. de Almeida, a Redemptorist in Brazil. Every week he rows a wooden boat through the Amazon jungle, and then hikes almost two miles up the mountain, in order to celebrate Mass for tribal Catholic communities and to provide them basic life skills. On this WMS, through our support of missionaries such as Fr. Almeida and the Nguyen couple, their works become ours as well. Through our shared faith, Christ lives on, and a new heaven and a new earth begin.

Closer to home, the work of evangelization continues to take root at Sacred Heart, particularly through the RCIA program. This year the journey begins with eight "inquirers": Jennifer Jackson Lee, Victor Lee, Kramer Wagner, Rachel Rose, Chelsey Liwag-Estrada, Rebecca St. Pierre, Benoit St. Pierre, and Jeff Wells. Of this group, three are from religious traditions other than Roman Catholic, and five are baptized Catholics who wish to deepen their faith. As a community of missionaries, please extend your warm welcome to our inquirers whenever you cross their paths. They and their RCIA leaders (Lee Cox, Gerry Guinasso) would also appreciate your daily prayers.

After more than a decade of steadfast services to Sacred Heart parish, Larry Pomada (facilities supervisor) recently asked to retire in order to devote quality time and energy for his extended family. Larry however remains open to resource our parish as a consultant. From all of us, God's abundant blessings and our heartfelt gratitude to you and your family, Larry!
