

In today's gospel Jesus describes two kinds of people – those who initially say "no" but then change their hearts to carry out the tasks asked of them anyhow, and those who say "yes" but failed to follow through with their promise. In the end, it is those who fulfill God's will, who – by living out or following through with their inner convictions – are judged as righteous people who preserve their lives for the Reign of God.

As we gather to celebrate God's gift of the Eucharist, all of us are embraced by Jesus, whose eternal "yes" liberates us to live in the Holy Spirit. Let the power of the Eucharist awaken our individual and collective "baptismal yes" to follow Jesus Christ with joy and hope. Let His Eucharistic Love inspire us to live as faithful stewards of God's gifts of time, talents, and treasure in our everyday relationships.
