

Today we enter the most sacred time of our liturgical year. During Holy Week we see the best of us and the worst of us. On this Palm Sunday, we joyfully wave our palm branches to welcome Jesus, the long-awaited Messiah, into our lives. Our dream of a meaningful life is germinating.

On Holy Thursday evening we share an intimate "Last Supper" with Jesus. There, we re-learn humility and service from the Master – by letting him wash our feet and extending his humble service to others. Immediately after Mass, we process from church to the Adoration chapel (downstairs) with the Blessed Sacrament. While there, let us adore his "crazy" love for us and for all creation. On this night, we are disciples with the Master, friends in love.

On Good Friday as "the Passion of Our Lord" unfolds before us, we discover how self-giving Jesus has been for us and how sinful we are for crucifying him onto the cross. On this day we humbly take stock of our pitiful past and, in silence, venerate the love-soaking cross of Jesus, "because by Your Holy Cross You Have Redeemed the World."

At the Easter Vigil, we light the Easter Candle, the symbol of the Risen Christ, and let its fire drive out the darkness of our collective and personal sins. We sit and retell ancient stories of how God patiently find all kinds of ways to share life with us, guide us, forgive us, and ultimately save us. On this night, as the Easter water is sprinkled over us, we renew our baptismal promises. As we rise with Christ to new life, let us recommit to live as a people of Alleluia again.

Many thanks to those who kindly provided the soup, breads, drinks, and other good things for the "soup lunches and suppers" after the Wednesday noon and Friday evening Stations of the Cross. What a great tradition! Every time I took part in those meals, my heart danced with gratitude, knowing that each meal was prepared with so much love. #### Good Friday, April 6 Day of Penance, Abstinence, and Fasting

On Good Friday, everyone 14 years or older is bound to abstain from meat. Everyone ages 18 to 59 is bound to fast. During fasting, only 1 full meal is allowed. Two other small meatless meals may be eaten to maintain one's strength, but these 2 small meals together should not equal the 1 full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.
