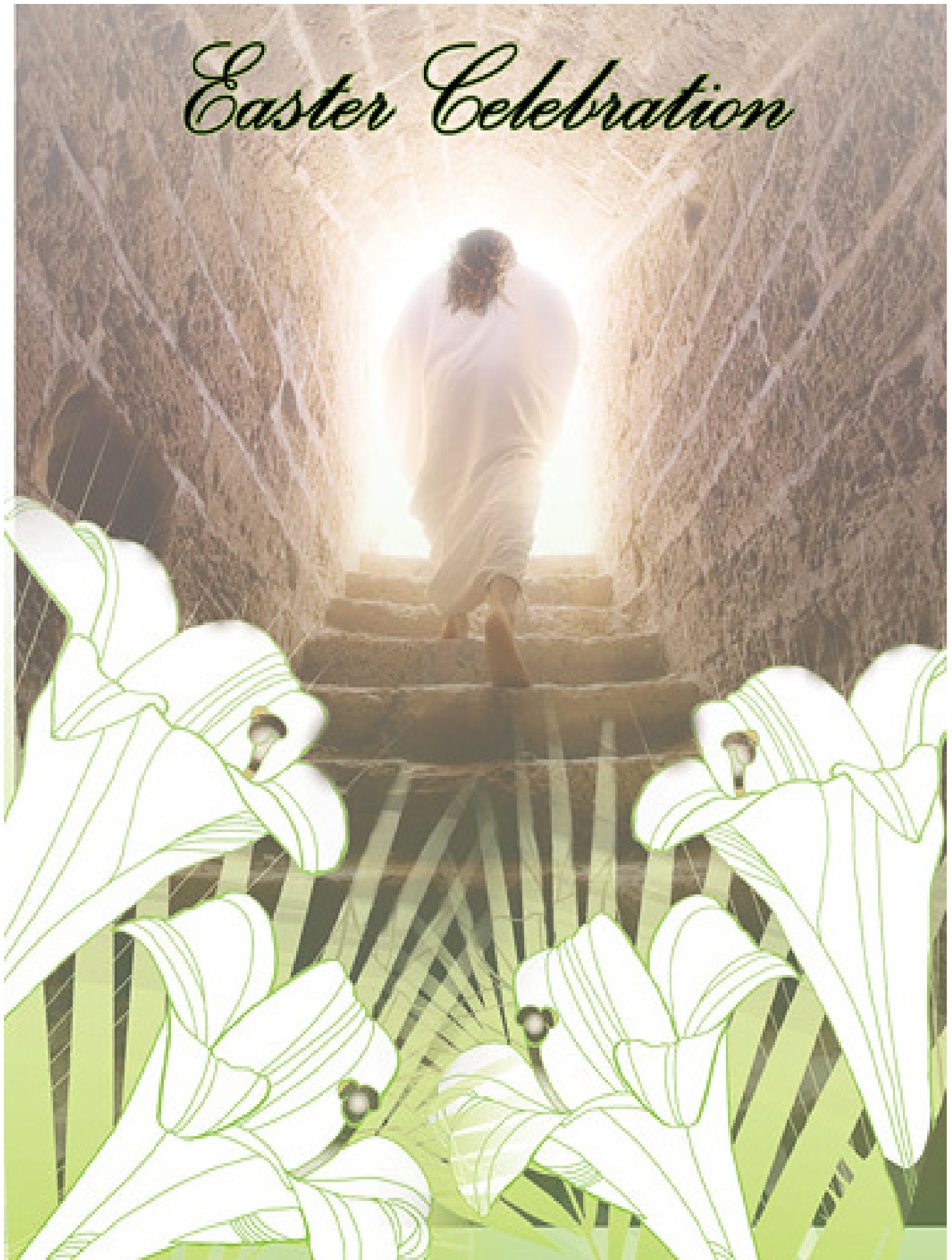


# *Easter Celebration*



Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

Nothing says “spring” like a walk (or, for Fr. Mark, a ride on his Smithsonian-worthy bike ... 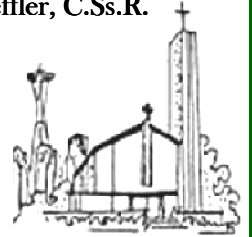
