

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

Pray that the Feast of Easter was a joyous day for all of you. In many ways, Easter reminds me of a grand wedding. Both events are fun to celebrate. Both occasions, filled with precious memories to be treasured, mark a new beginning. Both point to further life promises and challenges ahead. Once the cheery music & glitzy decorations are behind us, how the gift of Easter (i.e., wedding & honeymoon) be integrated into our daily life indicates lasting fitness, joy, and growth. The recent 40 days of Lent leads to 50 days of Easter joy and mercy.

Today we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. Our scripture readings are all about mercy. The opening prayer addresses God as the source of “everlasting mercy.” The responsorial psalm echoes it, always with a deep gratitude: *“Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His mercy endures forever!”* The word “mercy” is illustrated in life-giving action, by the early Christian community, which shares common treasures and communal prayer. In the gospel, Jesus entrusts to the Church the sacrament of forgiveness (John 20: 19-23). It is the gift of divine mercy – from God to us, and for us to keep practicing with one another!

At the 11 a.m. Sunday Mass, the Legion of Mary will lead us in celebrating Christ’s gift of mercy. After the liturgy, we will honor the newly baptized and confirmed – Andrew Davis, Chelsey Liwag-Estrada, Rachel Rose, Jeff Wells, and Victor Lee.

Early next week you will receive a postal letter from Archbishop Peter J. Sartain to kick off the archdiocese’s Annual Catholic Appeal. All parishes are asked to support the many good works of the archdiocese. More details are coming soon. Please prayerfully consider your continuing support.

We have received many positive feedbacks on the Holy Week liturgies from parishioners as well as visitors. Again, thanks to all, whose labor of love “transformed” liturgical celebrations into a spiritual uplifting! May the Risen Jesus refill your dedicated hearts with divine love and life!
