

In a near future, I wish to hold a Community Forum, to dialogue with you regarding the life and future of OUR parish. Through emails, verbal communications, and the "Comments Box" in the front vestibule, I have periodically received valuable feedback on a variety of issues, including the Archbishop's recent letter on Referendum 74. On the latter, the feedback have been both "for" and "against," often filled with deep emotion and seeming certainty.

At this point, regardless of one's current position (i.e., feeling, opinion, conviction) on the issue, I encourage all of us to take the letter to PRAYER, rather than diving into preconceived conclusion and then pointing fingers at each other. Seeking the truth and living it requires each person to step, first of all, deeply into the mind and heart of Jesus. It is a very hard yet necessary discipline for all of us to be faithful to the Gospel. The future of OUR parish depends on our ability to dialogue and work together. Convenient and appealing sound bites, including news media, often fall short. As people of faith, we need to pray before we can dialogue well. The Referendum 74 is one of many issues, such as an ever-deepening appreciation of the Sacraments and liturgical celebrations, pastoral care and spiritual formation (i.e., Bereavement Support Group, Catholicism workshop), effective stewardship and use of resources (i.e., facilities), etc., that we as a COMMUNITY of faith need to address.

Our parish, like all others in the archdiocese, commits to participate in the 2012 Annual Catholic Appeal. Please see further details in this bulletin.

This week all Redemptorists at Sacred Heart, except Fr. Pete (Bill Peterson), join our confreres for the annual assembly in Tucson, Arizona. We meet to discern and decide on our pastoral plan, i.e., road map for ministries. Please keep us in your prayers, especially to Mary.
