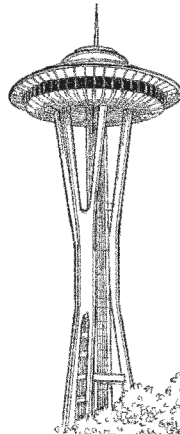

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

"Better the devil you know than the one you don't know." Such popular wisdom reflects why we are reluctant to change, even when our current situation is difficult or our lifestyle unhealthy. It is easier to hang on to what is, using familiar coping mechanisms, than to risk something new. According to Sr. Barbara Reid, such is the complaint of the Israelites to Moses in today's first reading. They would rather have stayed enslaved in Egypt, with all the suffering that entailed, than risked the freedom and new life into which God was leading them.

Last Sunday, Jesus fed thousands of hungry folks with five barley loaves and two fish. They wanted to crown him as their "sugar daddy." Today Jesus invites the crowd to shift their expectations from outward signs (being fed) to inner transformation (seeing him as the eternal Bread of Life and embracing his way of living). For Jesus, as we enjoy the gift, never forget the Giver! His feeding signifies reconciliation to God and to one another. As Jesus fed the crowd, strangers from diverse backgrounds sat together and ate the same meal in his company. Eating together, in his culture, implied letting go of past enmities, "putting on the new self...of God's goodness" (2nd Reading), and becoming God's "life to the world" (Gospel). In celebrating the Eucharist today, may we really see and embrace the meaning of this "sign"!

On Sunday, August 26, Archbishop Peter Sartain will help us honor Fr. Bill Cleary (former associate pastor) and Fr. Richard Quinn (former pastor), along with four other Redemptorist classmates, on their 50th Anniversary of Priestly Ordination. 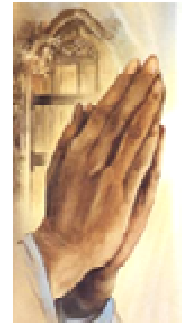
