

The four catechumens are Josue Alamillo, Chelsey Liwag-Estrada, Rachel Rose, and Jeff Wells. The two candidates (baptized but not yet confirmed) are Andrew Davis and Victor Lee. As they are "elected" to join our Catholic Church, please keep them in your prayers. They will be formally introduced to Sacred Heart parish at the 9:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday, March 4<sup>th</sup>.

- 6. Pray the Rosary. If you cannot do a full decade, try starting with just one.
