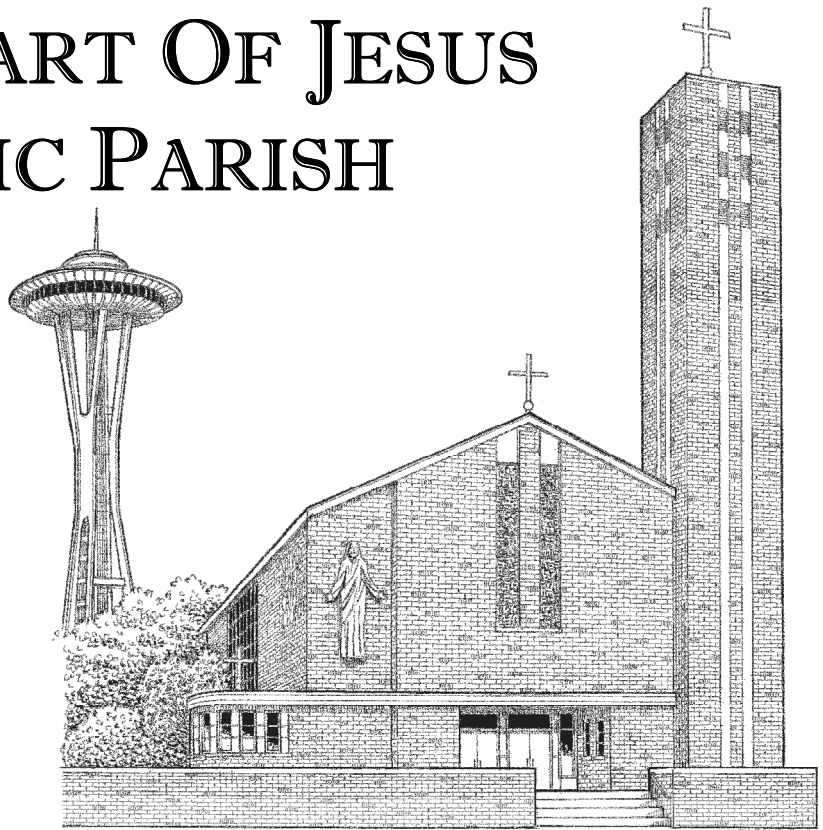

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

From the community of Redemptorists at Sacred Heart, happy feast day to all of you! Every third Sunday of July is the Feast of the Most Holy Redeemer. This feast day, for Redemptorists and partners in mission throughout the world, captures the heart of their spirituality. According to St. Alphonsus Liguori, the Founder of Redemptorists, *"the whole of Christian life is centered in Jesus and his work of redemption."* Here, the critical focus is not upon redemption as an abstract task, but rather upon the person of the Redeemer. Meditating on extreme ways which God, in the person of Jesus Christ, embraced to redeem us, St. Alphonsus penned a child-like yet profound description of Christ's inexhaustible love for humanity:

"Oh my sweet, amiable and holy Child! You are at a loss of what more to do to make yourself beloved by human beings. It is enough to say that from being the Son of God you were made the son of man, and that you chose to be born among humans like the rest of infants, only poorer and more meanly lodged than the rest...and you went on during the remainder of your life, ever showing fresh and more striking tokens of your love, so that at length you willed to shed the last drop of your blood and die overwhelmed with shame upon the infamous tree of the cross.."

Being the Redeemer, Jesus lifts up a model of redemptive living for all vowed Redemptorists, indeed for all of us baptized Christians. Each act of intentional self-giving can steadily evolve you and me, our home and work place and faith community, etc., into a redeeming heart of God. Imagine a holy and redemptive world!

We've been blessed with wonderful weather lately. As we enjoy God's gift of nature among family and friends, please keep victims of wild fires and heat waves in our prayers.

During these summer months, Sacred Heart becomes a temporary spiritual home for many vacationers. To our fellow Catholics and guests, welcome to our community of faith. 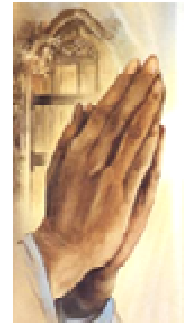
