



In extending our kindness to others, let us also attend to our own needs, so that we can do more in the name of Christ. Today, Jesus invites his disciples, who came back from a grueling mission, to rest in a quiet place ... WITH HIM.

For any committed Christian in 2012, our life is a continuing movement, at times a delicate tension, between responding to people's "real needs" and needing to humbly draw away to a restful place to be physically-emotionally -spiritually recharged, as well as to assess oneself (i.e., energy level, ways of doing, motives). In our constantly "wired" world (i.e., cell phone, internet, TV) living out such a balance requires humility-discipline-love from each of us and much grace from God. Dear God, please help us!

Essentially our Christian life, in order to be filled with joy and purpose and meaning, consists of being with God in a solitude place (i.e., heart to heart space), so that we may know our true selves and serve God in people we meet in the marketplace... and back again. Spend a moment with Jesus before the Blessed Sacrament, or read your spiritual book with a cup of tea on your home patio, or take a prayerful walk in a neighborhood park, etc. Be with Jesus often, and our "breathing" and our "sleep" will be easier.
