Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

Our gospel reading temporarily shifts to chapter 6 of John's gospel today (and the next four Sundays), focusing on Jesus as the Bread of Life. This chapter begins with Christ's multiplication of the loaves and fish, which is the only miracle story, other than his resurrection, recorded in all four gospels. Moved by people's hunger, Jesus responds with generosity. From a boy's "five barley loaves (bread of the poor) and two fish," Jesus multiplies his small yet precious offering to feed thousands of hungry people, and with so much more leftovers. In God's hands, nothing is too small or insignificant. All Jesus needs from each of us is a believing, generous heart to start with. I am grateful that our parish, though struggling to operate with limited resources, continues to feed hungry folks, shelter homeless men, support struggling families, etc. In truth, there won't ever be enough for all our greed, but placing your and my generosity in God's hands and working with God, there is always enough for all our needs.

This coming Wednesday, August 1st, is the feast of St. Alphonsus Liguori. He is the founder of Redemptorists (who have served Sacred Heart and this Archdiocese for over 120 years). Through the course of his 91 years of life (1696-1787) Alphonsus saw that the only motivation for God coming and living and dying for his creatures is love – pure and simple! "An omnipotent God, Lord of all and supremely happy in himself ... [loves] human beings to the extent of appearing to be out of his mind." God's absolutely insane love for us is to hopefully inspire us to love God and other people in return.

Alphonsus responded to God's love with a faithful life of prayer and multifaceted service, as a lawyer, priest, bishop, musician, artist, spiritual writer, moral theologian. During his last 20 years, he suffered greatly from arthritis, which confined him in a wheelchair. He was also almost blind and partially deaf. At all our Masses this weekend, we invoke his intercession as we pray for God's healing upon those who suffer with arthritis and similar ailments.

I will be in Houston from August 2nd through 10th to celebrate Kevin Zubel & Quy Duong taking their religious vows to become Redemptorists, to baptize my family's two precious newborns - Abigail (niece) and Tyler (grandnephew), and to preside at an 80th birthday anniversary for my best friend's parents, etc. In addition to those I will also be enjoying Texas barbeque, margaritas, tennis, and fishing in 100° humid weather! :)

To maintain the quality of our facilities and services, our parish leadership has been exploring practical, responsible steps for several small needed projects - church's sound system, Fellowship Room and its extension, front doors, Mother of Perpetual Help hall (school gym), and Adoration Chapel. More details will be forthcoming in a near future. Please keep these projects in your prayers.
