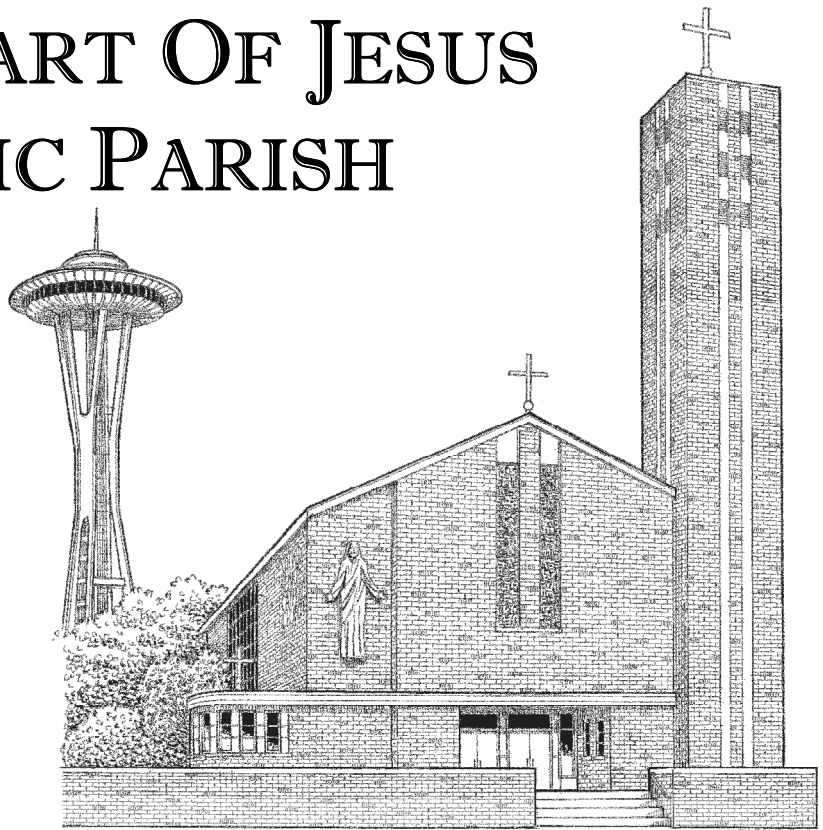

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

This week we enter into the heart of Christian faith: the Most Holy Trinity. Our faith affirms that there is only one God and that our God exists in three persons: Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit. This faith is ultimately an unknowable mystery because God, by definition, is ineffable, beyond imagination, beyond language. That said, as revealed in the Holy Bible and affirmed by human experiences, we get a glimpse of this mystery in light of our Triune God's relationship with us, for us, and even one of us.

Today's readings recount the Triune God who gives birth to us (creation), protects Israel/us (liberation from slavery), and guides us with covenantal love (i.e., Mosaic Law). In Jesus the Emmanuel ("God with us"), the Triune God takes on human flesh as one of us. The Holy Spirit enables us to share in Christ's divinity. We thus become God's beloved children, being adopted to participate in the Trinitarian life. Wow, what a gift of love!!! With divine help, may we continue to live faithfully live this dignified relationship!

Again, a heart-felt gratitude for your sacrifice to the Archdiocese's Annual Appeal! Our parish has reached 78 % of the designated amount (\$42,185.00). Your generosity confirms my trust that we will meet our parish goal. That said, to those of us who have not contributed, including our guests, please help Sacred Heart fulfill our commitment/duty by this coming week. May God the Trinity transform each contribution into an act of love to serve the poor/marginalized throughout the Church of Western Washington!

On loving service, you'd be proud to know not just how many lives our parish Food Program has touched, but also how dedicated our staff and volunteers have been. Please see an updated report in this bulletin, and keep up your prayers for this ministry.

A tidbit of future events to keep us posted: Our Pastoral Council, assisted by the Liturgy Committee, is planning a parish celebration of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (patron feast day), and a 3-day Novena to honor Our Lady of Perpetual Help. More details will be forthcoming.
