Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart:

St. Mark must have written today's gospel "with Sacred Heart parish in mind." The twin-parable on the seeds is about the birth and gigantic growth of God's Kingdom in our lives from very humble beginnings. The seed of faith lies dormant within each of us. And when – indeed, only when – it is nurtured by the Holy Spirit (i.e., through self-surrendering, prayer life, works of charity and human rights), the seed grows – initially slow yet steady and persistently – into miraculous proportions, to the point of allowing "birds of every kind" (read: spiritual oasis/home for ALL PEOPLE) to rest and be reenergized.

Here at Sacred Heart, I have regularly witnessed such kinds of seeds growing. Last month, an Alaska Cruise visitor from Philadelphia, while handing me a check of \$35.00, commented: "Father, thank you. Your parishioners are so welcoming. The folks serving coffee (in the Fellowship Room) were friendly and generous. If I'd ever come back to Seattle, this will be my spiritual home."

Another seed: Staff and volunteers of our Queen Anne Food Bank have been working very hard on the "Stock the Shelves" fundraising event. Be proud and supportive of this noble ministry. Details of the fundraising event are in the bulletin.

Though our parish is relatively small, may our faith always be large and our kindness continues to expand (as guided by the Holy Spirit and blessed by our Mother of Perpetual Help). The Liturgy Committee has in place an inspiring 5-day Novena to honor Our Mother of Perpetual Help. The information is in this bulletin. Please mark your calendar, and invite family and friends and neighbors to celebrate our Blessed Mother together.

Last week, I was blessed with some quality days with my dad (86 years young). On this Father's Day, I wish to join all of us to pray for our dads – deceased or living – with a poem, "Father":

An understanding, loyal soul
A heart of tenderness,
A mind all wisdom, knowing how justice and love to blend;
A teacher, loving, patient, kind,
My Father and my friend."*

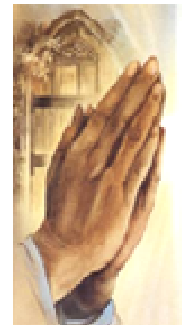
