

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

Welcome to Summer 2012! This Sunday we celebrate the birthday of John the Baptist. As a rule, the annual feast of a saint occurs on the anniversary of his or her death. In the case of John the Baptist, we celebrate his death (August 29) as well as his birth (June 24). Aside from the births of Jesus (December 25) and the Blessed Virgin Mary (September 8), the only other birth we honor as a solemn feast is St. John's.

The gospel on the birth of John focuses on the naming ceremony. According to Fr. Tony Kayala, in biblical times, and still today in many cultures, personal names function the way business names do, that is, they aim to convey what the bearer of the name stands for. The name John means "God is gracious." His birth signals a new era in God-human relationship, to be characterized by grace. John was born to introduce Jesus, the incarnated Son of God, to humanity and to prepare humanity for Christ.

At our baptism, each of us was named a Christian, that is, a person who lives Christ-like examples because s/he is an icon of Christ Jesus. What a privileged character and destiny for us as Christians!

This weekend our parish begins a five-day novena to honor Our Mother of Perpetual Help, leading up to her annual feast on Wednesday, June 27. Novena, what is it? It is a time-tested practice to deepen one's habit of prayer, and thus to grow in Christ. Traditionally, a novena is a prayer or set of prayers repeated for a period of time, i.e., hours, days, weeks. In prayerful devotions, we invite our Blessed Mother to be a part of our lives; we share with her our needs and concerns; we invoke her powerful intercessions. Ultimately we, through her love and friendship, are lead into the Sacred Heart of Christ. There, we will experience his joy and peace as never before, and even radiate peace as his icon.

This year's five-day noven to Our Mother of Perpetual Help is dedicated to pray for our families, for each of us in living our Christian vocation, for those who are sick or dying, and for our parish's life and future. Check out the novena calendar and share with others this spiritual gift.


