



Today, Paul contrasts what we can achieve spiritually on our own merits (nothing), with what God offers us as undeserved grace (everything). Our goodness, such as it is, is really God's goodness shining through us. For the God who is "rich in mercy," we rejoice!

As an act of gratitude and as an expression of our faith, we are invited to participate more deeply into God's way, through several events at our parish today and this week. This weekend our parish holds a "Ministry Fair." At each Mass today, please welcome Chong David, Alex Soto, Christian Wong, or Pat Nolan who will share with us their experiences of serving God here at Sacred Heart. After Mass, consider signing up to share your gifts of time and talents. There are representatives of current ministries available to answer your questions and help you to sign up. If there are needs not currently met, please offer your insights and be a part of the solution. Our parish can definitely grow in faith and services with one another, but only with your help.

Also this coming Saturday (March 24th), starting at 3 p.m., there will be a Lenten Reconciliation Service (i.e., Sacrament of Confession) specifically for all parishioners in the church. We will have three priests to help us receive God's healing mercy, so that to energize us to practice "mercy" anew with each other.

During Lent all parishes in the U.S. participate in the annual collection for Catholic Relief Services. We at Sacred Heart will do so at our next weekend Masses. This important collection, being managed by the U.S. Catholic Conference of Bishops, helps to protect families by providing basic humanitarian aid and life-skills training to those in need, protecting poor families, and advocating for policies that strengthen families here and abroad.
