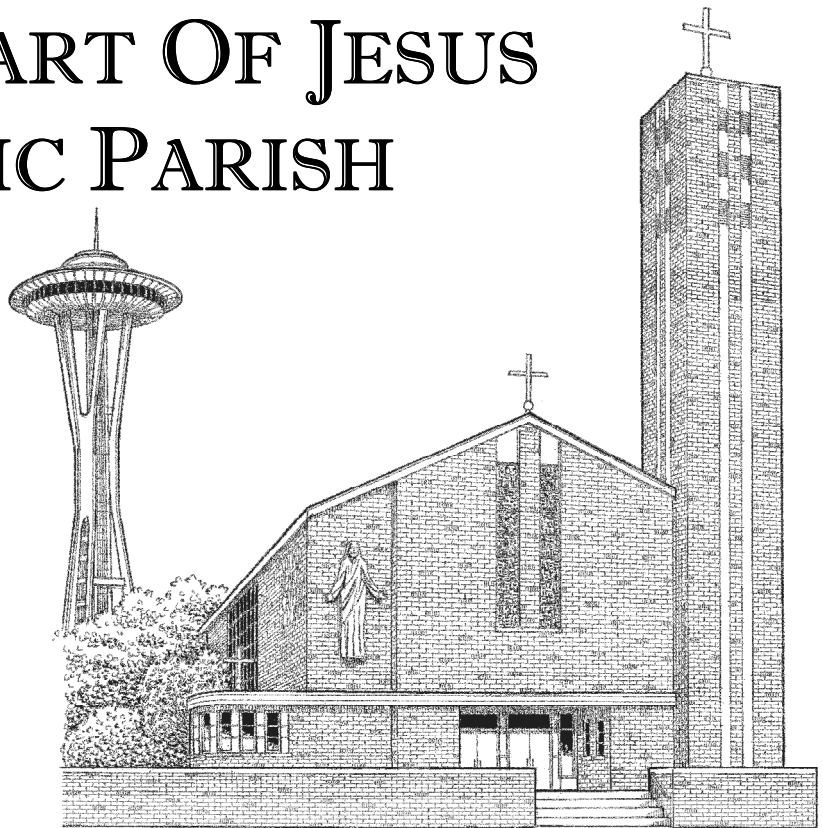

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

Today's readings unlock a fascinating secret for living a Christ-centered community. The Letter of John points us to the twofold bond that unites all members of such a community: "Believe in the name of God's Son, Jesus Christ, and to love one another." For John, love is neither easy nor romantic. It manifests itself in heroic acts – reaching out to those who have turned away (coded: former or disconnected Catholics); welcoming those whose lives might be different. For example, in Acts, the disciples in Jerusalem, on the word of Barnabas, overcame their distrust of Paul's past as a persecutor. They accepted him, and even protected him when his life was in danger. From this cradle community of Christian love, Paul grew into one of the most fervent apostles for Christ, even to the point of martyrdom.

Note that love, as quoted above and firmly stated in the gospel, is not a matter of personal preference, but is based on faith/friendship in the Risen Lord, "Remain in me, as I remain in you." Using the vine and branches metaphor, Jesus insists that without an intimate friendship with him, it is impossible for a Christian community to build or maintain a life-giving relationship with one another. Growing in Christ and thus with one another compels us, individually and collectively, to continue to nourish our prayer life and communal celebration of God's gifts of the sacraments.

Canonization of Blessed Peter Calungsod

A Mass will be celebrated at Immaculate Conception Parish (820 18th Ave. Seattle) on October 21 in conjunction with the canonization of Blessed Peter Calungsod by Pope Benedict XVI.

Blessed Peter Calungsod, whose feast day is April 2, was martyred as a young man in 1672 while serving as a missionary in Guam. He was beatified by Blessed John Paul II on March 5, 2000.

On Dec. 19, 2011, the Holy See approved the second miracle needed for Blessed Peter's canonization: a Filipino woman who had been pronounced dead two hours after a heart attack was revived when a doctor prayed for Calungsod's intercession.

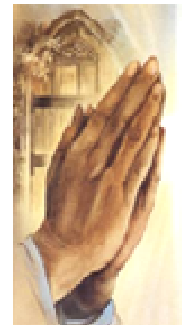
