




Gerard seemed especially concerned about women who desired to be mothers. He died at the age of 29 on October 16, 1755 from tuberculosis. He was beatified in 1893 by Pope Leo XIII and canonized in 1904 by Pope Pius X. Since his death, prayers offered by mothers having difficulties conceiving a child or during pregnancy have been answered. *www.themotherssaint.org*
