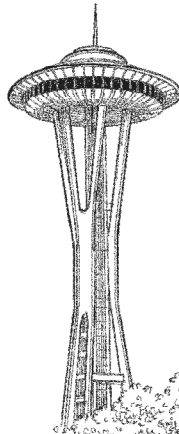

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

It is tempting to label James and John in today's gospel as insensitive and tone-deaf to what Jesus was about to suffer and face death. These Zebedee brothers foresaw Jesus in glory after his ordeal, and thus reserved for their places of honor. Their attitude seems quite normal since we can endure "suffering" if we know our condition will come to an end and be greatly rewarded. Today, Jesus even purifies that hidden motive. He once again patiently shows us, with and through his own life, another humble lesson – seeking "to serve rather than to be served." What a hard-swallowing lesson to digest! Yet, in our sane moment, we know the "culturally irrational" way of Jesus leads to personal joy, communal peace here and now, and eternal life to come. In fact, it is the only way that makes sense, as Peter once confessed to Jesus, "To whom shall we go, Lord, you have the words of everlasting life."

On this World Mission Sunday we are united with all fellow Catholics in prayer, friendship and service. We share in the work of missionaries as they, inspired by the Holy Spirit, serve lives, build schools, and provide basic human needs to marginalized people, often in dangerous circumstances. Today's second collection support mission projects worldwide. Please give what you can; every gift makes a difference.

This past week 34 people participated in the "training/refreshing" session for Lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist. Your willingness and generosity to serve fellow parishioners deeply inspire me. Thank you. May you know Christ's abiding joy through your service!!

November 2nd is the feast of ALL SOULS. On this particular day and throughout the month of November, we Catholics practice a time-honored tradition of praying for our deceased family members, former parishioners, friends and acquaintances. Canonization of Blessed Pedro Calungsod October 21, 2012

Blessed Pedro Calungsod, a catechist from Cebu Philippines, was martyred at age 17 on April 2, 1672 while on a Jesuit mission in Guam. He was beatified by Pope John Paul II on March 5, 2000 and will be canonized on October 21, 2012 by Pope Benedict XVI. He is the second Filipino saint.

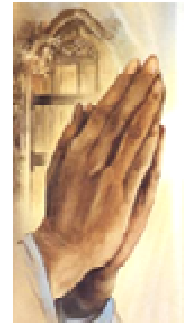
Fr. Lyle Needs Calendars
