



Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

Soon after our first day in August 2011 both Fr. Mark and I, being newcomers, realized our need to learn from your collective wisdom. How to live Catholic faith and strengthen Sacred Heart parish? Besides verbal conversations, we eventually initiated a "Suggestion Box" to gather your comments, questions, insights, etc. Since then, about 45 people shared their thoughts in writing. Today, I would like to respond to some of your inputs (and the remaining in future opportunities).

- 1. "Catholic Catechism for Adults" "More faith teaching [on] what it means to be & live Catholic lives intentionally, not accidentally by childhood baptism" -> Good points! Last Spring, we conducted a 10-session DVD series on Catholicism by Fr. Robert Barron. Those who came greatly enjoyed it and found it enriching. Good news is: Starting this Sunday, after the evening Mass, our YAMS hosts the first showing of the same series in the Fellowship Room. Please make the time and give yourself a chance for faith enrichment. Another good news: Join our RCIA program, starting at 7 p.m. this Wednesday night. Still another good news: To help us celebrate the Church's Year of Faith, a series of faith formation on "Conversion: For Saints and Regular Catholics like Us" is in the plans to be offered later this Fall. Watch for it in future bulletins.
- 2. "Great work continuing the valuable services of the Food Bank." Thank you. It allows us to live out Christ's mandate of caring for him in the less fortunate. Please continue to support this worthy cause.
- 3. "Refresher training for lectors/EMs so that the parish achieves a level of consistent execution at every Mass, every weekend, and every season." Excellent suggestion! Two opportunities have actually been scheduled: 10 a.m. on Saturday, October 13 and 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 16. Please prayerfully step up to serve your fellow Catholics. And if you are a minister, make time for the refresher training.
- 4. "All speakers are mumblers [sic]. They, including the priests, need to be trained in speaking into the mike loudly and distinctively." Thank you for your reminder. I will personally try to improve.
- 5. "More fellowship group activities" "more/continued building community" "the groups of Seniors, YAMS, and those in the middle need to mix socially" "More activities for parishioners such as church dinner, etc." Yes, I am with you. Every past luncheon or social event was so much fun. Regrettably, those events tend to be burdened by the same group of parishioners. So, will you call me ... and together we invite other (new) people to help organize another dinner in the foreseeable future.
- 6. "We are happy & lucky to have you both as a team (Fr. Mark & Fr. Binh). The two of you compliments [sic] each other & have done a lot of things in a span of a few month" "You seem very open and welcoming" "Very good priests ... I hope to see them here for a very long time." Thank you. I too am very grateful for Fr. Mark. He got my vote to be the next pastor:)
