

1. To honor our Mother Mary and to assist us to reap the benefits of the Church's "Year of Faith," the Pastoral Council invites all to participate in a "Rosary Novena" on each Tuesday during the month of October.
2. The Legion of Mary sponsors a Rosary Rally next Saturday, October 6th. This annual event brings a large, culturally-diverse group of Catholics throughout Seattle to Sacred Heart for a day of prayer.
3. Two opportunities of training for Lectors & Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist: 10 a.m. on Saturday, October 13 and 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 16. Please prayerfully step up to serve your fellow Catholics. And if you are already a minister, make time for a "refresher."
