

St. Ignatius (founder of the Jesuits) taught us "finding God in all things," or that God can be found in every one, in every place, and in everything. And every aspect of our being, desire, action, etc., is meant "for the greater glory of God." St. Alphonsus (founder of us Redemptorists) taught that our God, the Creator of heaven and earth, loves us so dearly, way beyond human comprehension. So humble and merciful, this almighty Divine went to impossible length to demonstrate that love: Became a vulnerable infant Jesus, died for our sake on the most shameful form of the Cross, desired to be with us and to nourish us until the end of time through the Eucharist, etc. God, through and with and in Jesus Christ, assures us "plentiful redemption." It's thus only appropriate that we respond to God's love with genuine, faithful, and generous love, especially in prayers ("to pray is to be saved") and through our kindness to fellow human beings who are "poor and most abandoned."

On being kind to disadvantaged folks, our parish Food Bank is offering a job opportunity, salary with benefits – "Operations & Outreach Manager." This great ministry has positively impacted so many lives. Its job description is available on the table in the church's front vestibule. Applications are accepted until Monday, August 12th. If you or someone you know are interested, please pray over it and act soon.

We have in place a "Steering Committee for 125th Anniversary." This group represents a wide spectrum of our Sacred Heart parish. We met last week to begin our planning ways for all of us to THANK God for so much blessings up to this day, to CELEBRATE who we are and what we have accomplished, and to RENEW/RE-VISION our future as a parish. Fr. Mark and I have been discerning a possibility of forming a Knight of Columbus Council here at Sacred Heart.
