Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

Thank God for many holy people walking in our midst! They are 2013's Abraham(s) and Sarah(s) who have lived "dark moments of suffering and uncertainty" with an incredibly dignified faith in God. I have met them – through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, counseling, chit-chats in our parking lot, after Mass, at wedding rehearsal or coffee shop, in their home, etc. They represent a wide spectrum of life – aging parent, young adult, sister/wife, mechanic, homeless, lawyer, lapsed/returning Catholics, devoted volunteer, etc. As I meditate on today's readings, I thought of them and remembered their heartfelt words, "How can I forgive my sister who's been cruel to me?" "I feel like hating God for not taking my cancer away...but I feel so guilty for doubting God" "Many of my friends and family are either 'avowed atheists' or just plain 'secular-minded'... [so] I've been feeling pretty lonely, trying to live my Catholic faith and help the Church" ... On and many other similar sentiments! Yet, amidst our conversations, their amazing gifts of faith shined forth, summarized by several sincere convictions: "Beneath my confusion, doubts, loneliness ... It's strange that I also feel God always being there" "Father, I can't describe God in words and it may sound arrogant, but I have TRULY MET God before in my heart, even for a few fleeting seconds. My only hope now is to hang on to God, especially during difficult moments." Friends, watch out for holy Abraham/Sarah in our midst. Perhaps, you are one! Faith, what a marvelous gift!!!

This coming Thursday, August 15th, is the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, who is lifted up "into Heaven" – full, joyous union with God! It's a Holy Day of Obligation/Opportunity to rejoice with our Mother Mary, and to celebrate God's promise of Heaven for us. Please check this bulletin for our Mass schedule on this feast day.

The "Steering Committee for 125th Anniversary" will meet this coming Thursday evening, after the Mass of Mary's Assumption. Great works so far. 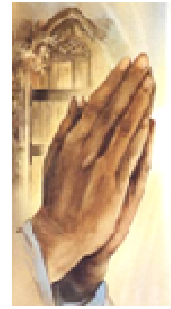
