



Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

As Jesus continues his fateful "narrow" path to Jerusalem, he deflects an age-old concern of "Will only a few people be saved" to a deeper reflection: Who will be in Heaven? How? Why? When? Fulton Sheen, a saintly and genius American archbishop, once prophetically quipped, "There will be three surprises in heaven. First, many people we expected to be in Heaven are not there. St. John of the Cross offers a reason for being absent: "At the evening of our life, we shall be judged on how we have loved." Second: Those whom we think unqualified for Heaven are there. Only God sees human hearts clearly and reward us accordingly. The third surprise: We are in Heaven. "Being in Heaven" is above all a GIFT from God, who "desires everyone to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth" (1 Tim. 2:4). Saying "strive to enter through a narrow gate," Jesus advises us to not take God's gift (i.e., life, faith, family, \$, time, talents) for granted, but rather to cooperate with his undeserving grace with a life of gratitude, of unconditional and generous sacrifices. Jesus and Mary lived just that! How can we be any different?

At all Masses this weekend we welcome back Fr. Joe T. Ngo, who generously served his first years of ministry at Sacred Heart. Fr. Joe is sent here to preach on **Co-Redemptorist Association** (CRA). The CRA is a concrete way for you to partner with Redemptorists in spreading Christ's love and teaching to all, especially the marginalized. Since 1891, Redemptorists have faithfully served many generations of "us/you" at Sacred Heart and throughout the Archdiocese. All Redemptorists serving here were, and to an extent still are, helped by the CRA. So, your partnership is invaluable and critical for our continuing services here. Thank you in advance for your generosity!

A brief update on our parish's "125th Anniversary" planning: Various committees have been formed. They will soon be introduced to you, as they begin to seek your inputs in selecting concrete events and projects, so that all of us can participate and enjoy. Please continue praying for this gift of anniversary.
