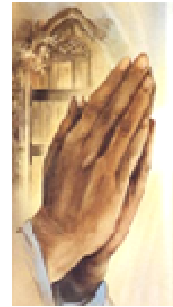
Pilgrimage to the Grotto in Portland, OR: July 20
