

St. Alphonsus Liguori founded the Redemptorists in 1732. Their mission is to strive to follow the example of Jesus Christ in preaching the Gospel to the poor, particularly to those who live in the margins of Church and society. Alphonsus died on

August 1, 1787 and was canonized in 1839. 1

His devotion to the Eucharist, as evidenced in his Visits to the Blessed Sacrament and his love of Christ crucified, as seen in his still popular Stations of the Cross are two signs of his continuing influence on Catholic piety today. The statue of St. Alphonsus is in the rear of the church. ²
