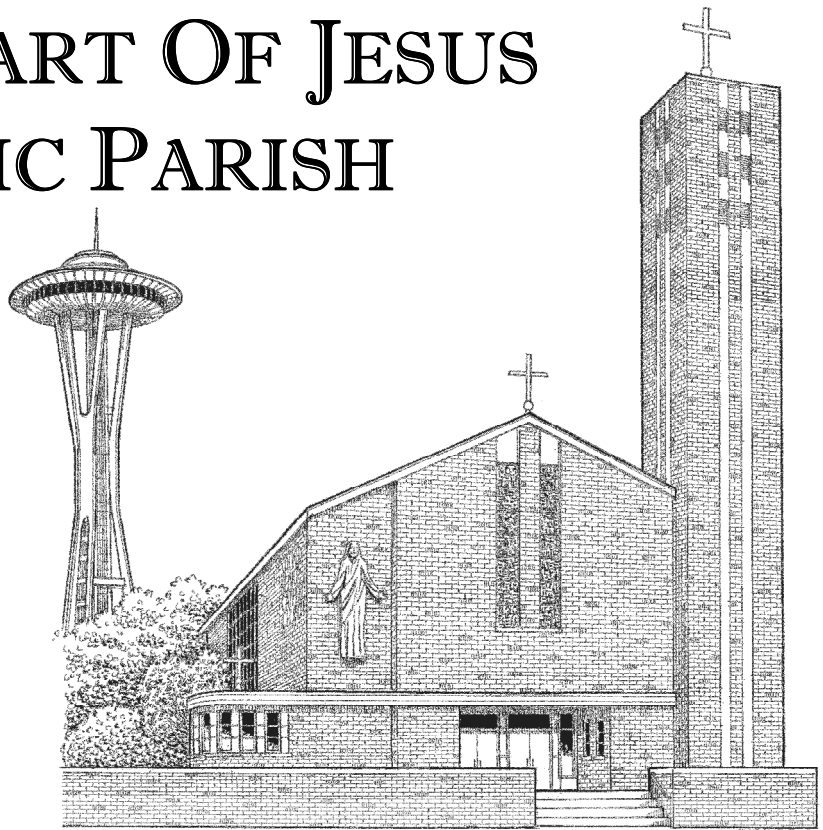

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

Mahatma Gandhi, known as “*Bapu*” or “father” of India, greatly admired Fr. Damien (now St. Damien of Molokai). Gandhi once asked what energize and sustain the latter to work among lepers in Hawaii. Fr. Damien’s source of inspiration and sustenance, according to a confidant, is the Eucharist.

I am deeply grateful for all Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, who bring Christ to our fellow Catholics – at Mass, at home, or in a hospital. Please consider to serve in this ministry.

As Christ’s Body and Blood heals and nourishes us on our pilgrimage to eternity, our sacrifice to the Archdiocese’s Annual Appeal is a reciprocal service to his body, especially to sisters and brothers in destitute condition. Sacred Heart has reached 84% of the assessed amount (\$40,157). To all who have not contributed, please help our parish meets our commitment. God’s blessings for your kindness!

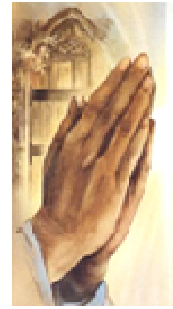

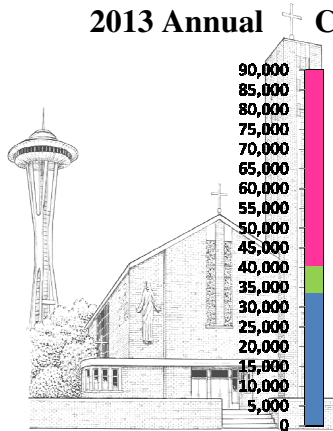
