



Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

I am deeply grateful for all Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, who bring Christ to our fellow Catholics – at Mass, at home, or in a hospital. Please consider to serve in this ministry.

As Christ's Body and Blood heals and nourishes us on our pilgrimage to eternity, our sacrifice to the Archdiocese's Annual Appeal is a reciprocal service to his body, especially to sisters and brothers in destitute condition. Sacred Heart has reached 84% of the assessed amount (\$40,157). To all who have not contributed, please help our parish meets our commitment. God's blessings for your kindness!


