After 40 days of Lent, we now enter the most sacred time of our liturgical year – the Holy Week. Regardless of how much we've spiritually grown during Lent, this week invites us to let every liturgical ritual, word, moment of silence, etc., sink deep into our hearts and transform our lives.

On this Palm Sunday, we joyfully wave our palm branches to welcome Jesus the Messiah into our desires, thoughts, and behaviors. During the Sacred Triduum (three sacred days), may we re-learn humility and service from the Lord through the washing of feet on Holy Thursday; may we discover and live the depth of Christ's crucified love for us on Good Friday; may the light of the Risen Christ dispel the darkness of our collective and personal sins on Easter Vigil. On this holy night, as we renew our baptismal promises, may we rise with Christ to new life and recommit to live as Easter people once again!!

On Holy Thursday, immediately after Mass, we process with the Sacred Host to the Adoration Chapel downstairs. Ten RCIA candidates have been primed for the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist on Easter Vigil. Please continue to keep them in our prayers, as they enter their last days of preparation to become full members of the Church.

As Lent gradually turns toward Easter, I have so many reasons to be thankful. First off, thanks to all generous hearts who provided soups, drinks, and other good things after the Wednesday noon and Friday evening Stations of the Cross during Lent. Every soup, prepared with much love, was so tasty. And your friendly smiles truly exemplified Christ-like spirit! Thanks also to those who helped serve and cleaned up afterward. Moreover, thanks to everyone who came to pray as well as to share the meals!
