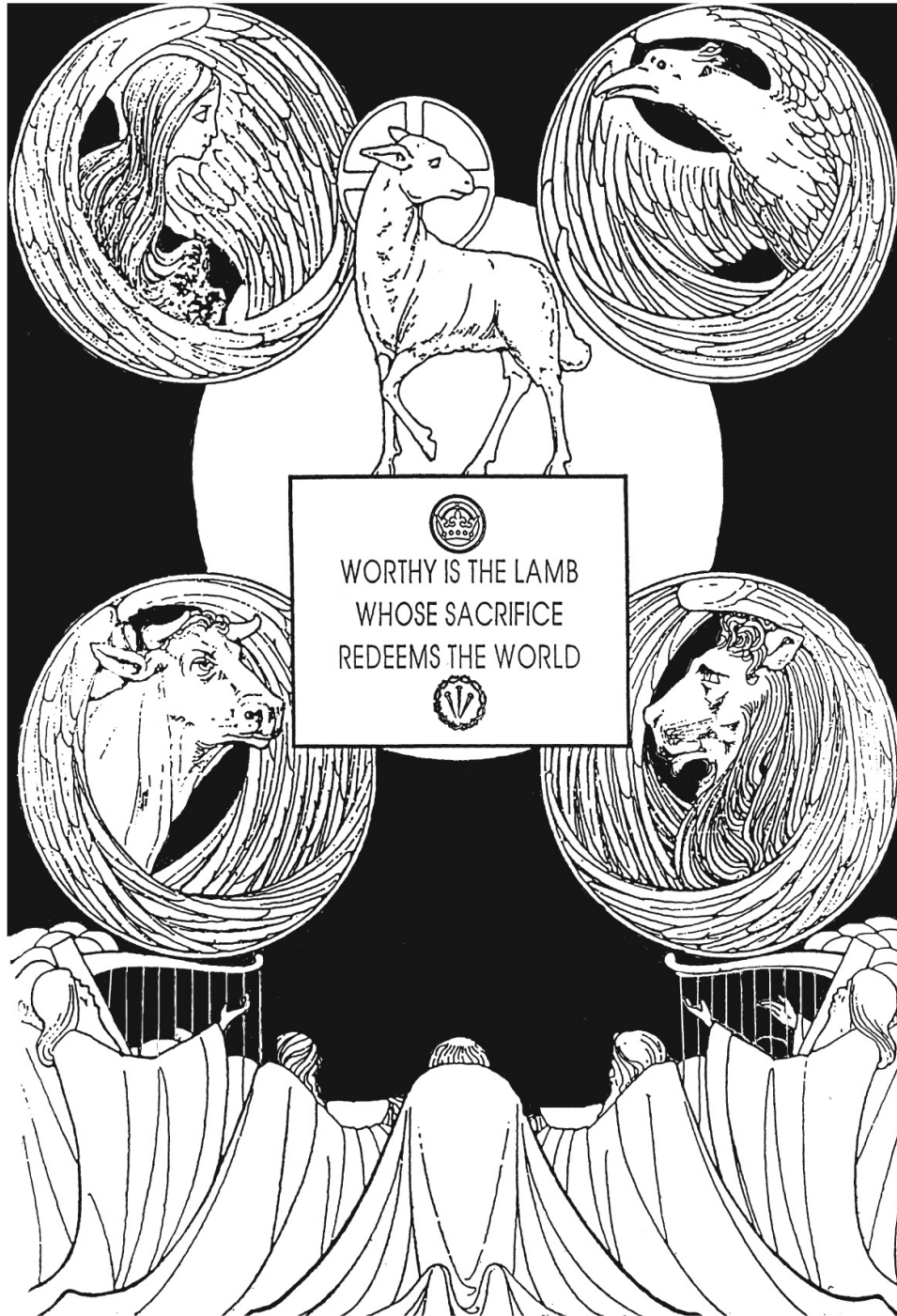


Easter Celebration

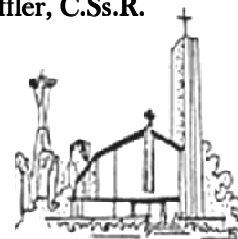

April 4, Easter Thursday

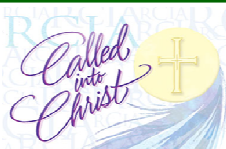
