Dear Parishioners and Friends of Sacred Heart,

Though I often remembered and prayed for you while giving a retreat to Redemptorist students in Wisconsin and celebrating my anniversary Mass in Texas, it is wonderful to “return home” again. If you feel lost in any way, why not lay your “lostness” on Christ’s Table of the Eucharist or at Mary’s shrine. Allow God to find you once again, and again, and again. Welcome back. Glad you are in your home!

On “being home” for one another, our parish will offer a “Ministry Fair” at all Masses next weekend. Your gifts of time and talents are important and needed. See YOURSELF a “God-sent brick” that keeps Sacred Heart standing strong, a “gentle door” that welcomes visitors and fellow parishioners, a “serving chalice” that channels Christ’s love to one another at Mass, etc. During this week, please take time to pray and consider of sharing God’s gifts to you in at least one ministry. “Be home” with God and for each other!

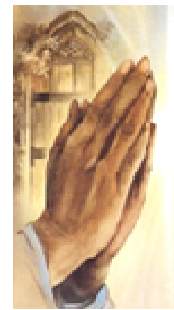
